All exams require a written order from your physician.

HOSPITAL PARKING

Free visitor parking is available in Lot 3 across from the Bedford Building. Enter from 6th Street. Valet parking is available at the 7th Street and Bedford Building entrances for a fee – or free if you are a handicapped motorist. Deck parking is available on 7th Street for a fee based on your length of stay.

DIRECTIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT

PET scan (7th Street parking deck is the closest parking) is located in the main hospital on the second floor. From the main hospital lobby, take the elevators to the second floor and follow the signs to the "Outpatient Department." Sign in using the kiosk (iPad) and have a seat in the waiting room.
