SUMMARY OF THE EXAM

An arterial blood gas (ABG) is a test performed on blood that is drawn from an artery. The artery is located in your wrist, or just above the bend in your arm. Since arterial blood has recently passed through the lungs, an ABG gives your doctor a good idea of the condition of your lungs.

WHAT TO EXPECT

You will feel a sharp stick when the needle is inserted into your arm

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- □ Please bring a written order from your doctor to the exam
- □ Please bring a complete list of all your medications
- □ Please bring a driver's license or other photo ID
- □ You may eat and drink as usual.
- □ Your doctor will specify whether the blood sample should be drawn while you are breathing supplemental oxygen or room air. If your order says that you should be using oxygen when the sample is drawn, bring your portable oxygen device with you.

LENGTH OF EXAM: Plan on spending about 20 minutes at the hospital for the arterial blood gas.

AFTER THE EXAM: You may eat and resume your normal activities.

HOSPITAL PARKING
