

Vaccine Registration for Local and Out-of-county Health Departments

Please note, this information may be changed or updated throughout the process.

Alliance City Health Department: Vaccines will be administered at the Alliance Senior Citizens Center. The clinic will be held on Jan. 20, 2021, for those who are 80 years of age or older. Call 330-821-3348 to sign up or learn more. *Alliance information may be updated soon for registering/scheduling.*

Canton City Health Department: Registration for those who are age 80 or older and live in the city limits of Canton will begin Thursday, Jan. 14, 2021, at 9 a.m. Individuals in this age group can complete a simple online form available on the website at cantonhealth.org or by calling 330-451-6774.

Massillon City Health Department: Starting Jan. 14 at 9 a.m., residents can call 330-830-1710 or 330-830-1714 to register/get scheduled between 9 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. They must make an appointment – no walk-ins.

Stark County Health Department: To register for vaccination, call 330-353-9010. The department will start scheduling those 80 years of age and older beginning at 9 a.m. on Thursday, Jan. 14, 2021. Those who are 65 years of age and older and those with congenital or developmental disorders will be placed on a waiting list until it is their time to receive the vaccine. *School personnel and those remaining in group 1a should schedule through their facility and then send to us at covidvaccine@starkhealth.org.*
