

# VISITATION RESTRICTIONS

VISITORS MUST BE 18 AND OLDER.

Upon entering, all visitors must have their temperature scanned, answer all screening questions honestly and obtain a name tag. **Wear the name tag and mask at all times while in the facility, INCLUDING IN THE PATIENT ROOMS.**

Visitors will be required to follow the guidance below even if they are vaccinated. If you are unable or unwilling to follow this guidance, we cannot offer in-person visitation.

For the safety of everyone, perform hand hygiene often and socially distance from other people.

## EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT

ONE VISITOR.  
OUTSIDE OF DESIGNATED VISITATION HOURS, ADMITTED EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT PATIENTS WILL BE PERMITTED ONE VISITOR UP TO 2 HOURS AFTER ADMISSION TO THE INPATIENT UNIT.

## LABOR AND DELIVERY (IF APPLICABLE TO THIS LOCATION)

TWO DESIGNATED VISITORS WHO MAY STAY 24/7.

## SURGICAL OR PROCEDURAL PATIENTS

ONE VISITOR FOR SAME DAY SURGERIES OR PROCEDURES.
