Visit an urgent care center for minor illnesses or injuries when your primary care provider is not available. Urgent care centers are available to treat:

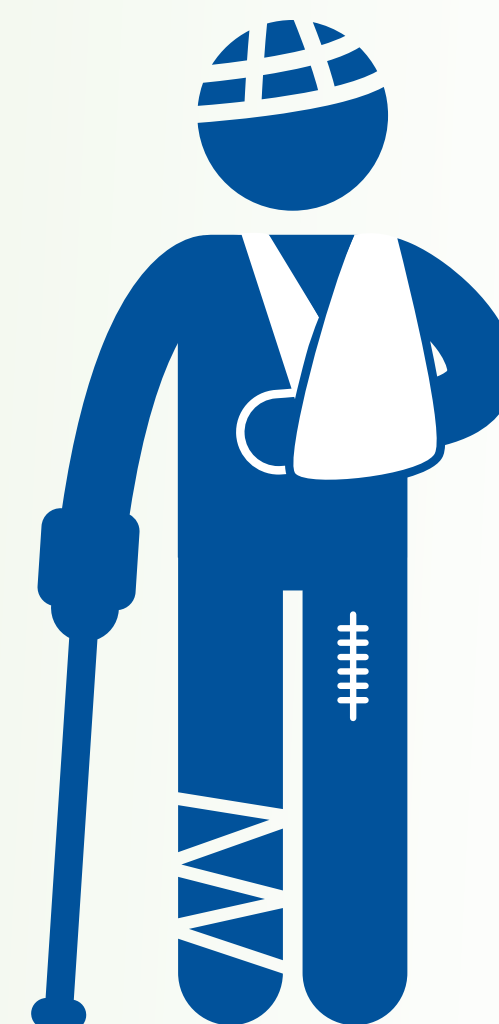
- Cold, flu, bronchitis or cough.
- Aches, pains or headaches.
- Fever or sore throat.
- Other non-life-threatening conditions.



EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT

Visit an emergency department or call 911 as soon as possible for these symptoms:

- Stroke or heart attack symptoms.
- Deep cuts or bleeding that won't stop.
- Behavioral health needs.
- Other life-threatening injuries or illnesses.



PRIMARY CARE

Make an appointment with your primary care provider if you are experiencing any of the following symptoms:

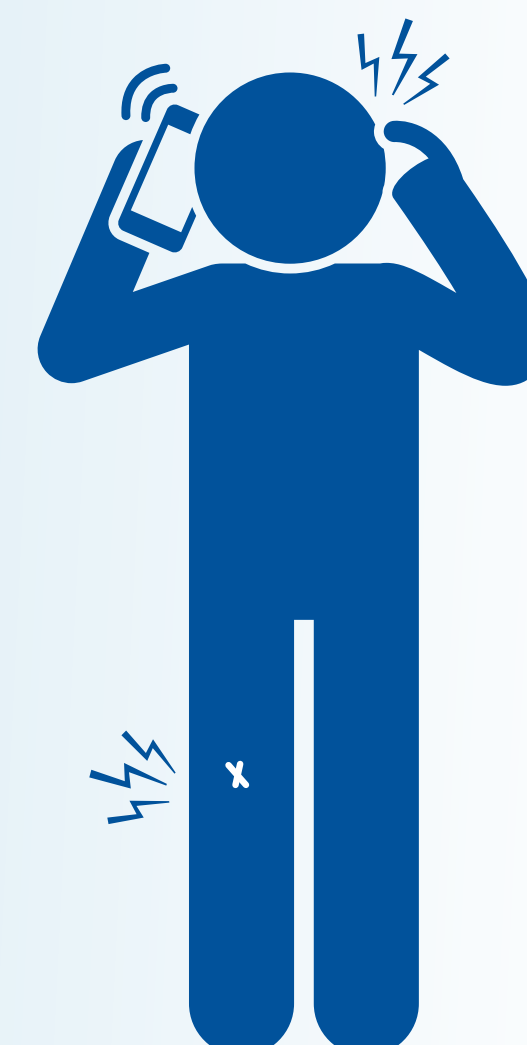
- Cold, flu, bronchitis or cough.
