Wheelchair Assessments

Specially trained Aultman therapists will provide a comprehensive assessment of your physical needs, understand the environments in which you will use your wheelchair and discuss your mobility goals.

Together with National Seating & Mobility equipment experts, the clinic team will recommend a mobility base and seating tailored to meet your specific needs and maximize your independence and function.

Aultman and National Seating & Mobility will work with your insurance provider to explain all the options that are available to you.

What We Need From Your Provider

- Provider prescription and clinical notes for a custom manual or power wheelchair.
- Patient demographics and insurance information.

Next Steps

- Contact the Aultman Wheelchair Clinic at 330-834-4101 to schedule your appointment.
- A National Seating & Mobility representative will schedule an assessment of your home to verify that the wheelchair can be used safely in your home.

What to Expect at Your First Visit

- An Aultman therapist will provide a physical assessment. The National Seating & Mobility equipment expert will measure you to determine the size of the equipment needed.
- Based on your diagnoses and needs, the team will select equipment to trial with you.
- Recommendations will be made to you and sent to your provider for their approval.
- Equipment recommendations will be submitted to your insurer for prior authorization.

Please note that your wheelchair clinic assessment will take approximately one hour.

Insurance Coverage

- Manual and power wheelchairs are covered by most insurers for patients who meet the medical guidelines established by each insurer.
- You will be informed of financial responsibility PRIOR to any equipment being provided.
- If you have previously received a wheelchair, you may be eligible for a new wheelchair if your condition or body has changed or if it has been five or more years since you received your wheelchair.
